#### Instructions:


- Print the Nursery Rhymes Printables Story Retelling Worksheets.
- Choose a nursery rhyme to focus on.
- Read or recite the nursery rhyme with the child, emphasizing the sequence of events.
- Cut out the four pictures located at the bottom of the worksheet.
- Examine each picture and discuss how it relates to the nursery rhyme.
- Identify the numbered spaces on the worksheet that correspond to the sequence of events.
- Match each picture to the correct numbered space and glue or tape them in place.
- Encourage the child to retell the nursery rhyme using the pictures as visual prompts.
- Repeat the process for other nursery rhymes, exploring different stories and sequences.
- Display the completed worksheets as a visual representation of the nursery rhymes.

Who sat down beside her,




## **Itsy Bitsy Spider**




#### **Twinkle Twinkle**








## **Humpty Dumpty**




### Wheels on the Bus






## Baa Baa Black Sheep




#### **Row Row Your Boat**

If you see a little fish, Give it a little hook.


