# Dove Liffe Cycle





**Dove Life Cycle** 

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Some call them doves. Some people call them pigeons. But no matter what you call them, these birds are pretty amazing!

Let's take a look at their life cycle.

Doves gather sticks. feathers, fur. hair - almost anything they can find to build their nests.



Once their nests are built, female pigeons will lay their eggs.

It takes about 18 days for the eggs to hatch. Then, the baby doves slowly make their way out. They are now called hatchlings.

Hatchlings depend on their mother to feed them. They stay in their nest and do not move around much.



After a few days, the baby birds grow. They are now called squabs. They can see better and walk around their nest more. They begin to get curious about the world around them.



Soon the babies start to grow their flying feathers. Now they can start flying lessons with mom!



Fledglings will fly out of the nest with their mothers and practice flying, walking around, and finding food. Their mothers much teach them everything they need to know to survive before they leave the nest.



Very soon after they're born baby doves grow into fullygrown birds. There are many different kinds of doves! Can you see any in your neighborhood?

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








#### Building a Nest





Birds work hard to gather materials for their nests.

They spend days and days looking for sticks,
plants, animal fur, and hair.



A nest begins to form. Birds have small beaks and bring materials back bit by bit. They use their beaks to knit together the materials they bring.

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After many trips back and forth, the nest has a shape. Birds make their nests stick together by using mud, spider webs, or their own saliva as a type of glue. Now the bird can fill it with softer materials it finds to make it cozy.



Finally, the nest is ready!

Birds usually build their nests during the warmer months in the city when they are preparing to have babies, or reproduce.

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What do you think happens next?



The bird will lay its eggs!
Soon baby birds will hatch from these eggs and live with their mother until they are ready to fly away. Then they will build nests of their own.
